

## **RULES**

1. All exhibits must have been grown or made by the exhibitor.  
(Bought flowers/foilage allowed in Classes 1,2&3 however.)
2. Entry fee – 50p. Children’s sections free.  
Exhibitors may make more than one entry in each class.
3. All exhibits to be staged by 10.15am on the day of the Show. Judging to commence at 10.45am.
4. The judge’s decision in all cases to be final.
5. No exhibits may be moved before 2.15pm.
6. Exhibitors to provide their own vases, plates and trays etc.
7. Exhibitors wishing to retain their entries should remove them between 2.15pm and 2.30pm. Those remaining after 2.30pm will be auctioned for Church funds.
8. Children’s sections to be the child’s own unaided effort.
9. All ordinary care will be taken of all exhibits, but the exhibitor alone will be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur from any cause whatsoever.

11. Entries in the cookery section may be cut, opened and tasted at the judge’s discretion.  
Photography to be judged in two classes –
  - a. ORIGINAL PHOTOGRAPHS as taken by camera unprocessed or manipulated – cropping in printing is allowed.
  - b. DIGITALLY MANIPULATED IMAGE original has been enhanced, changed, or photoshopped, after taking, but is still recognisable as a derivation of the original image.Photographs will be judged on 3 elements 1) Creativity  
2) Composition and 3) adherence to the theme
12. Points will be awarded for 1st place (2) and runners up (1) and the exhibitor with the most points in each section will receive a trophy in the adult entries. Points for children’s 1<sup>st</sup> place (3) 2<sup>nd</sup> place (2) 3<sup>rd</sup> place (1) and trophies as specified in the schedule.
